GRANT WRITING WORKSHOP

Hosted during the annual NATA Clinical Symposia & AT Expo, the NATA Foundation brings together a group of nationally recognized mentors who have obtained success with external funding agencies to help athletic training investigators maximize their chance of securing research funding. The NATA Foundation Scholarship Program is one of the organization's most highly regarded programs. The number of scholarships varies annually (from 50 to 75), with the amount of the award currently \$2,300 per scholarship. 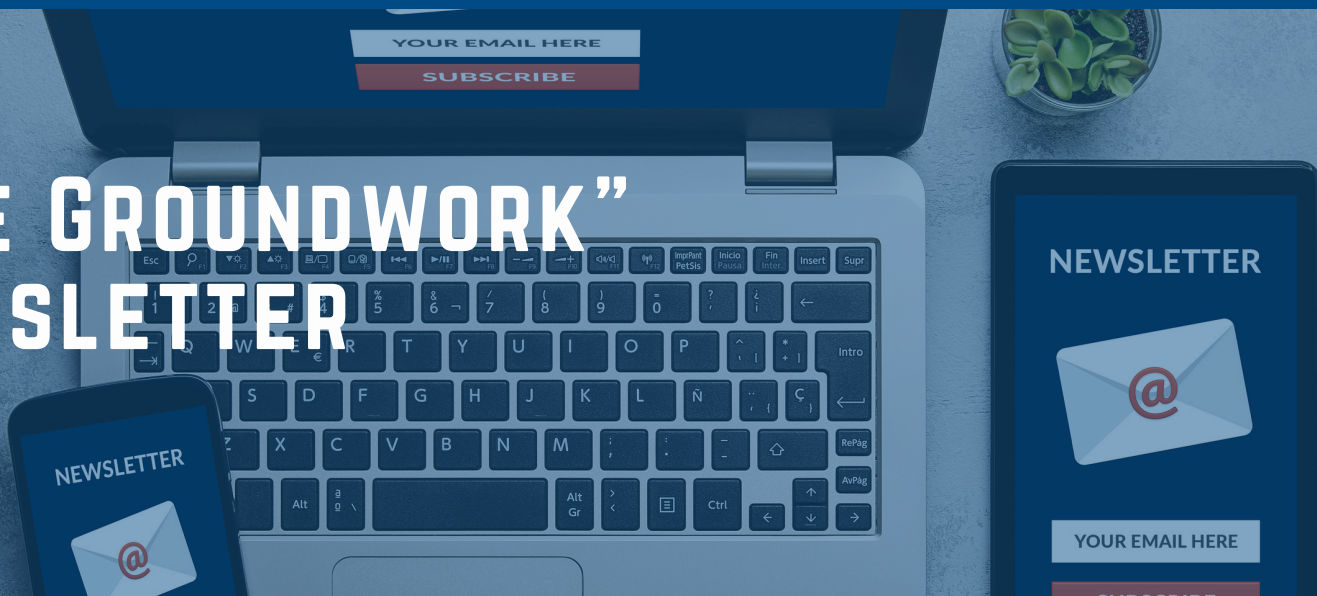

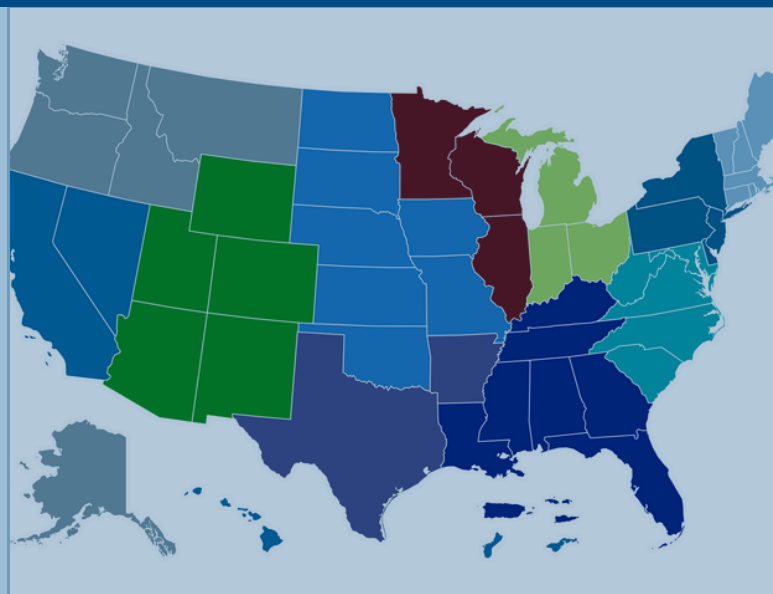
